COVID-19 Procedure

- Each patient is responsible for monitoring symptoms of possible Covid-19 infection. These symptoms include but are not limited to cough, fever, shortness of breath, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and body aches. If a patient has any symptoms, they are asked to reschedule appointments until symptom free.
- Patients are requested to limit the number of persons accompanying them unless needed for care or if patient is a minor.
- Masks are optional at this time. However, patients with concerns of infection or at high risk for complications are encouraged to wear masks and may ask staff to don masks as well.
- Patients are asked to use hand sanitizer upon entrance to clinic.
- Staff will clean equipment used during a session with appropriate cleanser proceeding visit.
- Linens will be single use and laundered between patient use.
- High contact areas, including door handles, will be cleaned frequently throughout the day.
- Scheduling will be spaced to prevent interactions between patients entering/leaving the clinic.
